

Guide to Good Practice in Corneal Pathology and Corneal Surgery, Retinal Eye Disease and Retinal Pathology

The Guide for best practice in the field of the diabetic eye diseases, corneal and retinal pathology was published in 2019 as a result of the medical activity within the project RECALT- „Regional Centre for advanced laser therapies in Ophthalmology”. The authors of the guide are members of the medical team that implemented the project: Lecturer MD Stanca Horia Tudor, As. Prof. MD Mocanu Valeria, Prof. MD. Munteanu Mihnea, Assoc. The guide has 80 pages and is available in Romanian and Serbian. The guide is structured in 9 chapters targeting corneal refractive surgery, diabetic retinopathy, retinal venous occlusions, and the utility of micropulse laser in retinal pathology.

The chapter of corneal refractive surgery presents in a synthesized form the most important details about laser procedures, initial patient evaluation, postoperative follow-up and possible complications.

The chapter of diabetic retinopathy describes diabetic ocular disease in detail, its clinical signs, screening stages and recommended treatment according to the condition of the disease.

The eighth chapter of retinal vein occlusion provides in concise mode information about patient initial evaluation and follow-up recommendations.

The utility of micropulse laser in retinal pathology is described in the last chapter providing clear information about the ocular pathology that requires this treatment and the procedure itself.

All this information is supported by a varied bibliography of more than 140 references.

This guide is very useful in the day-to-day medical practice of ophthalmologist specialists, giving them clear indications according to the severity of the disease.
